Dancing Monkey Pantin

Tools and materials required

2 sheets of heavy card stock

Scissors

Paper punch

Heavy duty thread

6 small paper fasteners (found at all craft stores)

1 Jingle Bell



Instructions for assembly

1. Carefully cut out all pieces of Pantin.
2. Trace the head and body shape onto another piece of card stock, then cut out. (This shape will hide the string pull mechanism inside the monkey).
3. Paper punch all brown and white holes.
4. Cut 4 pieces of heavy thread approximately 8-9 inches in length.
5. Tie one end of the threads to the 4 white holes in the arms and thighs. Double knot for strength.
6. Position arms and thighs to appropriate letter(A to A, etc.) Place paper fasteners into holes then place other body head shape onto fasteners hiding the strings inside. Fasten closed.
7. Fasten legs to knees.
8. Finish monkey by tying loose ends of thread onto jingle bell. Tie decorative floss through pom-pom on hat for hanging. Pull the string and watch the funny monkey dance.
